The Section of Infectious Disease and International Health at Dartmouth Health consists of eleven faculty members and seven fellows, along with associate providers, nursing staff, research and administrative staff. The clinical services of our Section include Hospital-based and outpatient consultations for the full spectrum of infectious diseases of adults and children, an International Travel Clinic, a comprehensive Infection Prevention Program staffed by physician epidemiologists and infection preventionists, a very active Antimicrobial Stewardship Program, an Outpatient Parenteral Antibiotic Therapy program, and a Regional HIV Program, which provides multidisciplinary care to persons with HIV in Lebanon, Manchester and Nashua, New Hampshire. The position includes telehealth opportunities and work with outside hospitals that do not have designated infectious disease providers on curbside consultations.
